The purpose of College Mentoring Experience (CME) is to give every at-risk or under-served minority student an opportunity to have a college education and to be prepared for college by their senior year of high school.

SCHOOL/SITE BASED

A small group mentoring program running in schools and community centers in Chicago. In Fiscal Year 2018, CME proudly expanded to serve over 180 children through seven different schools and community sites on the Westside.

1:1 / COMMUNITY

Community Based matches meet out in the community several times per month and participate in workshops, agency-sponsored activities, and receive tutoring through Sylvan Learning Center.


